- 1. Equip learners with knowledge of Indian Knowledge Systems (IKS), Traditional Knowledge (TK), Intellectual Property Rights (IPR), and People's Rights.
- 2. Provide insights into our rich heritage and key IPR topics, including Patents, Copyrights, Trademarks, Plant Varieties, and Geographical Indications.
- 3. Emphasize ethical research principles in TK, recognizing both codified and oral knowledge, with a focus on protecting the rights and livelihoods of knowledge holders.
- 4. Enhance academic and professional understanding of TK, IPR, and People's Rights, covering awareness, protection criteria, rights, and ethical guidelines for handling TK.
